

## EXHIBITION HALL WAS TOO SMALL FOR MEDJUGORJE VISIONARY

**“Without God, the world has no future and no peace” visionary Marija Pavlovic-Lunetti said outside of Verona on Saturday. The local mayor saw the prayer meeting as “an opportunity for reflection in a world where everything goes too fast, and you always have to dominate others”.**

Medjugorje visionary Marija Pavlovic-Lunetti was greeted by considerably more people than the Palariso exhibition hall officially holds when she guested a prayer meeting in Isola della Scala 19 kilometers outside of Verona on October 13.

“Palariso was crowded for Marija. The three thousand seats that had been prepared were not enough: the devotees who have shown their unconditional trust in the seer were many more, some with foresight had brought folding chairs from home, and many remained on their feet. The prayer meeting was packed for the entire afternoon” the online news magazine L’Arena reports.

In her closing remarks upon a five minutes long apparition, Marija paraphrased a message of the Virgin Mary by telling that “without God, the world has no future and no peace”.

“Our Lady is still here with us. She appeared, blessed us, did not give a message, but the message is that it is beautiful here with us” Marija informed about her apparition.

Bishop Giuseppe Zenti of Verona had given permission for the prayer meeting to occur, given that everything took place in a spirit of devotion to the Virgin Mary. Among the attendees was Giovanni Miozzi, mayor of Isola della Scala and president of the Province of Verona.
